INTERREG IPA CBC ITALY-ALBANIA-MONTENEGRO PROGRAMME, ON 6TH MARCH THE LAUNCH EVENT IN BARI

Bari, 6th March 2017 Save the date!

The launch event of the new Interreg IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro Programme is scheduled for March 6 in Bari: an important opportunity for dialogue and exchange, during which the 1st Call for Proposals – to be published shortly– will be presented, and guidelines for submitting project proposals will be given.

The event will be attended by Michele Emiliano, president of Puglia Region and by institutional representatives of Italy, Albania, Montenegro, European Commission.

The Programme, co-funded by the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA), has been established with the intent of giving more impetus to cooperation in the lower Adriatic sea, fostering smart, inclusive and sustainable development. Italy participates with two regions: Puglia - which also acts as Managing Authority - and Molise; Albania and Montenegro participate with the entire territory.

The Interreg IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro Programme has a total budget of 92,707,558.00 euro (including 15% national co-financing). The budget available for the first call is 25 million euro, spread over four priority axes (in terms of competitiveness of SMEs, tourism and culture, environment and water resources, sustainable transport).
