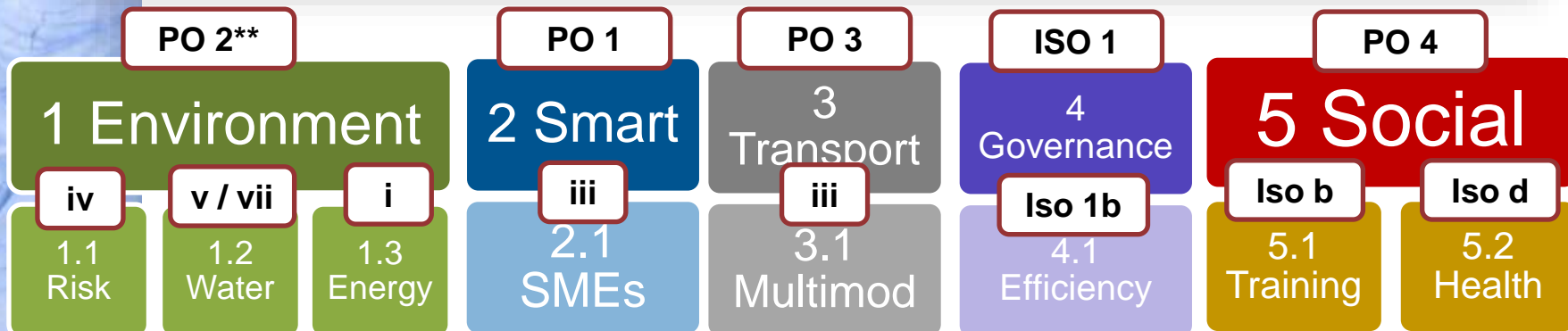

SO	S.O. 3.1 Developing sustainable, climate resilient, intelligent and intermodal national, regional and local mobility, including improved access to TEN-T and cross-border mobility, through joint cross-border actions



P.A. 3 cross-cutting - actions



Obligatory: One or more actions focused on S.O. 3.1 sustainable cross-border mobility / access to TEN-T nodes + Additional **cross-cutting actions** in coherence with S.O. and project scope are **possible** on e.g.:

- Multimodality e.g.
- Security at border-crossing, at ports, e.g.
- Accessibility of cultural sites/events for tourists e.g.
- Digital agenda, e.g.
- Pre-accession adoption of EU transport rules e.g.

Tourism and Culture as cross-cutting issue



S.O. Tourism/Culture/Creative industries - examples

1.1 Risk	actions for managing risks for natural / pandemic / botanic / animal diseases for the benefit of managers of cultural sites, touristic and cultural operators
1.2 Environ.	actions for natural heritage promotion, management of natural assets and water for the benefit of green, sustainable / slow tourism & cultural industries, incl. on circular economy targeting touristic or cultural operators, awareness raising through creative industries
1.3 Energy	awareness raising actions with cultural industries and touristic operators on CO2 reduction / energy saving
2.1 SMEs	actions focused on touristic SMEs and Micro-enterprises, family – agro – green tourism, actions to enhance cultural and creative industries

Tourism and Culture - cross-cutting / 2



S.O. Tourism/Culture/Creative industries - examples

3.1 Multim.	actions focused on transports for the benefit of tourists – touristic development, public transport links to cultural/natural sites
4.1 Gover.	actions focused on capacity of public administration to manage the joint cultural and natural heritage, cultural services
5.1 Skills	Capacity building and professional training in the touristic and cultural / creative sectors
5.2 Health	Actions focused on the touristic and cultural sectors, i.e. to improve healthcare services to tourists or to users of cultural services, including for specific target groups (e.g. tourists with special needs, elderlies, disabled etc.)

* P.A 5 Social: Current EU debate on possible additional social specific objective related to culture and tourism, might be added too

Complementarities Cross-border / Transnational Programmes / EUSAIR



TRANSNATIONAL & EUSAIR

- focus more on strategic macroregional policy-making
- Cooperation mainly at national and sub-national levels (i.e. NUTS I & II),
- both in a maritime and a land dimension

CROSS-BORDER

- focus more on concrete needs / obstacles
- for local communities (mainly NUTS III level)
- directly and indirectly deriving from the common maritime border
