



Interreg IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro CITIZENS' SUMMARY of the content of the Annual Implementation Report Year 2022

(Article 50(9) of Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013)

PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION & COMMUNICATION

While the 2014-2020 programme is about to close and the 2021-2027 Interreg IPA South Adriatic is about to start, the year 2022 was a highly productive year, marked with major progresses and excellent results achieved by the programme and its projects.

The savings of the closed projects could be used to launch a wide capitalisation initiative involving 20 capitalisation leaders: These actions are carried out to make sure that results of 20 standard projects of the First Call are widely used, transferred and followed-up on.

Also noteworthy were the progresses of the 8 Thematic Projects, focused on issues of particular interest for the programme area.

On the other side, the 40 projects (20 Normal + 20 Small Scale) funded under the Targeted Call continued to work on the achievement of the expected outputs, activating local communities and territories with their activities.

Thanks to its projects, the programme achieved all outputs set out by the performance framework, exceeding in several cases the targets originally planned.

Throughout the year, the Managing Authority and the Joint Secretariat provided support to beneficiaries through online meetings and direct assistance, in order to follow the progress of activities, identify strengths and weaknesses of the projects and develop recommendations for any necessary changes.

The programme evaluation also made major progresses: 8 evaluation reports were finalised and adopted by the Joint Monitoring Committee, the key findings have been publicised to the general public through <u>news/posts</u>, and are made available in the <u>programme website</u>.

The web portal – <u>https://www.italy-albania-montenegro.eu/</u> - was continuously enriched with contents referring to both programme and project activities. Websites dedicated to First Call Projects and Thematic Projects were updated with contents referring to activities and results. Websites and webpages dedicated to Targeted Projects were published.

The programme Facebook page <u>https://www.facebook.com/italy.albania.montenegro/</u> provided daily information and direct interaction with stakeholders and beneficiaries. With over 3.600 followers, and daily publication of posts, it is one of the most active pages among Interreg Programmes.

Two Joint Monitoring Committee meetings were held in April and November, finally in person, as the COVID restrictions were lifted.

Webinars and virtual events, alongside meetings in person, were organised to support beneficiaries, meet stakeholders, disseminate results and raise awareness about the role of the EU in supporting cooperation across borders. The extensive news coverage shows the interest of the Italian, Albanian and Montenegrin press for project activities and their impact on territories.

2022 was also crucial for the 2021-27 Interreg IPA South Adriatic (Italy-Albania-Montenegro). While the text of the programme and its annexes were ready for the submission to the EU Commission, the task force of the three participating countries agreed on a first call text, which was presented to all potential partners already in May 2022. As second Interreg IPA programme, on 26 September 2022 the EU Commission adopted the new Programme. Soon after that, the Monitoring Committee was established and had its first meeting in November 2022. During a series of National and Regional events, the new Programme was publicly launched and the text of the first call was presented. The first call was officially opened on 29/12/2022, with a budget of 5 million euros and focused on small-scale projects up to 200 thousand euros, implemented exclusively with simplified costs, as well as on the capitalisation of results and successful experiences in all 5 priorities of the Programme: SMEs, Environment, Transport, Inclusion, Governance. In addition, the Seed Facility continued the development of 5 strategic projects on creativity, resilience, connectivity, skills and governance.

In 2022, the European Year of Youth shone a light on the importance of young people in building a better future, and Tirana was appointed as the European Youth Capital. The Italy-Albania-Montenegro programme played an active role in these celebrations through a diverse range of activities that facilitated capacity-building and fostered intergenerational cooperation and mobility amongst youth. This involvement occurred within wider actions to enhance the involvement of young people, such as: 1) The programme's involvement in the Interreg Volunteer Youth initiative, and hosting of volunteers by projects (INTERFIDE, EFINTIS, REEHUB+) and the programme JS; 2) The performance of a cross-border musical band, created through the FAME project, at the "Puglia-Albania, Joint for Future" initiative; 3) Participation in public debates regarding youth involvement in EU cooperation, and in the Interreg IPA EUSAIR Youth Conference; 4) Selection of youth-focused projects (CIRCE, BIOTOURS), for visits from representatives of the European Commission and the National Youth Congress of Albania; 5) Artist residencies organised by projects (MONET, 3C), which enabled young Italians, Albanians, and Montenegrins to exchange experiences and become protagonists in European projects.

Building on all 2022 achievements, we are looking forward to 2023 challenges and opportunities, such as:

- Closing up all project activities, including the capitalisation actions and the investments for the 8 thematic projects;
- Communicating the excellent results achieved by projects;
- Closing up all management and control activities, without major issues;
- The launch of the actual implementation of the Interreg IPA South Adriatic.
