

Call for Standard Project Proposals of the Interreg IPA South Adriatic

Rules for open days

The JS offers information to potential applicants during the Call for Standard Project Proposals at meetings with open participation, called Open Days. The information provided at Open Days can be related to technical issues on projects' general scope, communication and finance management, as well as relevant issues related to the Call. During the Open Days the JS will provide technical advice on specific aspects that are unclear from the Programme and Call documents. Participation is limited to two persons per potential applicant / organisation.

Please note that

- Open days are not a pre-assessment and will not be based on a single Application Form or parts of it;
- The JS may clarify general principles but not advise on concrete outputs, activities or deliverables nor on e.g. the eligibility or suitability of the specific project proposal as such;
- Applicants are invited to use this opportunity after having carefully read the call documents (Application Tools Offline and the published Frequently Asked Questions).
- Questions cannot be focused on the consistency of the project with national or regional strategies and priorities (for these the relevant national/regional offices in charge shall be consulted).

As a general rule, open days will take place, with a minimum of **6 partners / organisations**, expressing their interest to participate, online

- on Wed 10/7/2024 (including JEMS targeted training), 11:00-13:00
- on Wed 17/7/2024, 12:00-13:00
- on Wed 31/7/2024, 12:00-13:00.
- on Tue 10/09/2024, 12:00-13:00.

For an effective participation, a maximum of 30 persons are recommended.

Participation in the Open Days is possible only **upon expression of interest through** <https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSf0HnL39iOLj2Jr-lzphA1M7Z1QOCVRK9YTgCZLS69NePhKJQ/viewform> well as subsequent **confirmation of availability, including meeting link, by email of the JS.**

Participation will be granted on a first-come-first-served basis and only as far as capacity of the JS allows it. Due to the limited capacity, individual participation cannot be granted to all potential applicants. Open Days are held in English language with the possibility to use Programme participating Countries languages according to the availability of the JS staff and participation in the Open Days. Questions and answers of general interest discussed at the Open Days may be published in the Frequently Asked Questions document on the Programme website.
